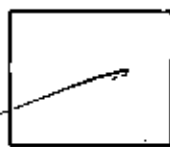
Introduction :- Our Nature has many amazing things that have been surprising to us. The Man tried to know about them and presented a coherent lore of Nature. This is called "Science".
