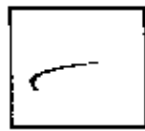

That question has been fully answered today by science.

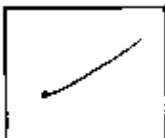
The modern age is the age of science. Science has brought about a complete change in the whole world. Impossible things have become possible.

travelling comfortable. We have faster and easier means of transport. We have buses, trains, aeroplanes. Now flights to other lands is possible.

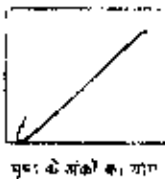
We have fastest means of communication. You can talk the person living far away from you.
