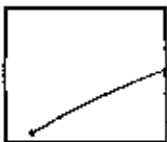

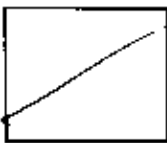

Mrs. Jones gave the answers very frankly and did not hesitate because

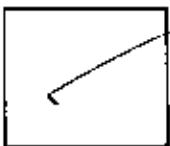
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she knew that snow was innocent. After inquiring he told her to go.

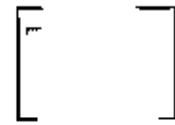
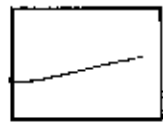
Games and sports have their an important place in ones life. Games and sports helps to develop many good qualities. As it is rightly said, "All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy".

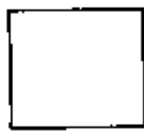
So, I request you to grant leave for a week on behalf of Robert, so that he may soon get well and join us to school again.

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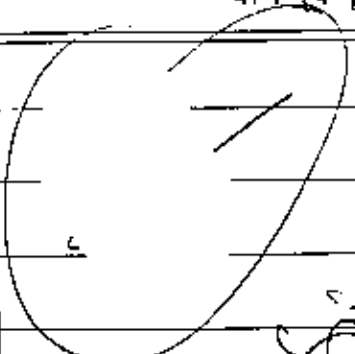
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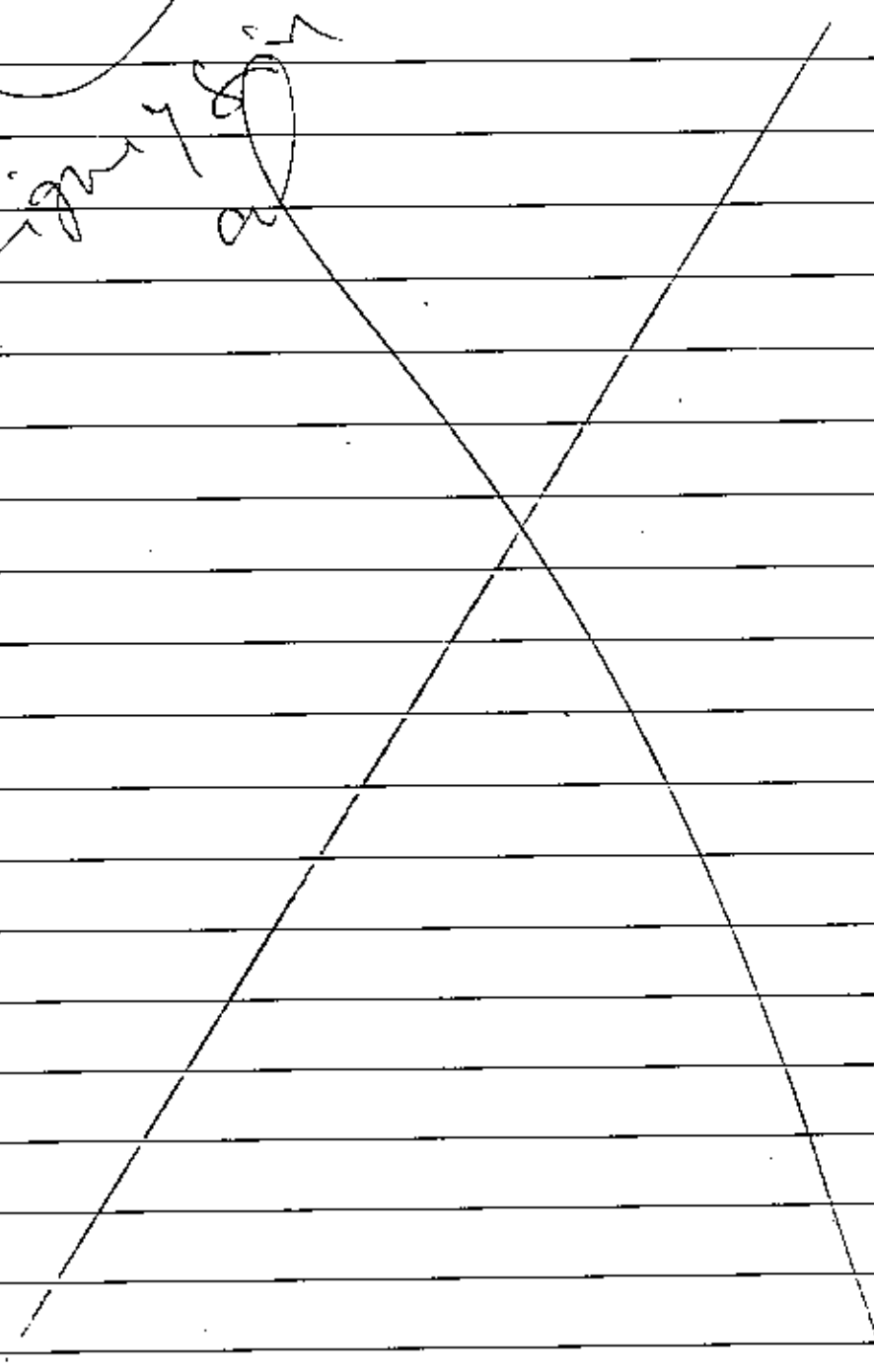
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
