Biography - Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru

Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru was born on 14th November 1889 in a Kashmiri Pandit Family. The name of his father was Motilal Nehru and that of mother was Swaroop Rani. He was educated in England in Independent Boy's school and Harrow in Trinity College Cambridge.

Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru was married to Kamla Nehru. In the first year of his marriage she gave birth to a daughter Indira Priyadarshini. Being the son of a wealthy father and a daughter, he soon became the leader of the left wing of the Congress party. Being a member and leader of the Congress party he also faced opposition with the Muslim League. To avoid communal riots he favoured partition of India into

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two parts viz. India and Pakistan in 1947.

Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru became the first Prime Minister of India in 1947 and imparted his famous speech 'A Trust with Destiny'. He served for India till 1964 and is the longest serving Prime Minister of India. He was also the founder of Non-Alignment movement. He shall always be remembered by the whole people of the world.

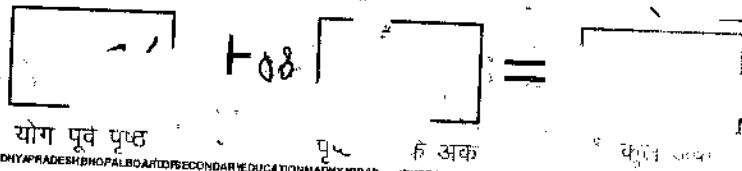

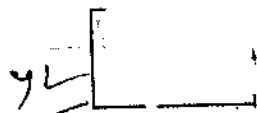

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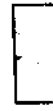

(b) Answer - The Geography master narrated a story in connection with a city. He told this story to prove the Wasserkopf's answer correct.

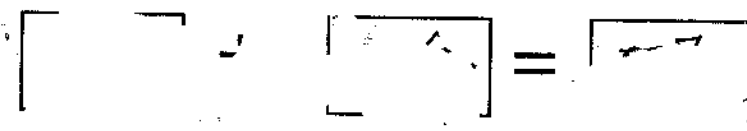
