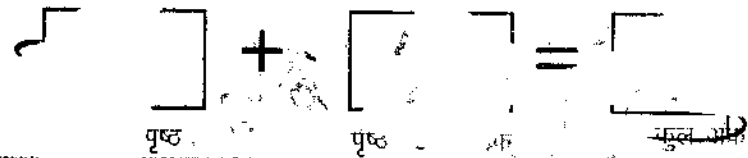

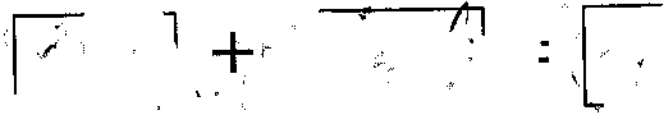

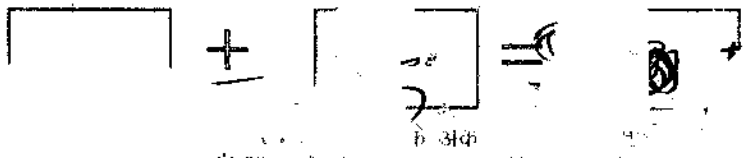

Rabindranath Tagore is very well-known to all of us. He was born on 7th May 1861 in Torasanko Menton in Calcutta. His father's name was Debendranath. The real name of their family was Banerjee. He was mostly raised by his servants, as his mother died in his early age and his father toured world wide.

He largely avoided the formal school education. He collected knowledge from reading at home and became famous for his writings. In 1941, Rabindranath Tagore founded a school at Shantiniketan near Bolpur.

He was a well-known poet. He wrote many short stories, many poems and several travelogues. He wrote many novels too. Gitanjali is his best known collection of poems which was written by him in the year 1910. It had beautiful verses. He was the first non-European to win Nobel Prize in literature. He got it for Greetanjali.

In 1905, while the partition

of Bengal, he emerged as a great poet of Indian culture. He was counted one of the best poets inspiring the freedom struggle of India.

During the protest against Rowlatt Act in 1919, Jallianwala Bagh Massacre took ^{place} which is well-known not only in India, but is foreign too. At that time, he surrendered the title in protest against the Jallianwala Bagh Massacre.

In the field of education too, his contribution is immortal and unforgettable. He inaugurated the Vishwa Bharti University in 1921 to support education for Indians.

This great person took his last breath in 1941 in Calcutta. After his demise also, he was not forgotten. "Jana Gana Mana" written by him was adopted as the National Anthem of India in 1950.

He will be remembered as a great personality for to hundreds of years.

Mahatma Gandhi is inarguably one of the greatest persons of India.

He was born on 2nd October 1869 in Porbandar, Gujarat. He completed primitive studies in India and went to England for higher studies. He went to South Africa for practice of law.

He was a great lover of truth and ahimsa. Wherever he went, he talked to the people in the way they understood. Soon, he was praised and appreciated by all. He inspired the Indians to fight the freedom struggle with truth and ahimsa. He told that for winning anything, the objectives and means should be pure.

He always worked to the welfare of the people. While his practice in South Africa, he fought for the rights of Indians and helped them ~~help~~ secure their rights.

In India, he encouraged the use of Charkha (spinning wheels). This

helped millions of people to find employment. It made the people self-reliant.

People started believing in the methods adopted by Gandhi for the freedom struggle. Gandhi sacrificed his life for Hindu-Muslim unity. He elaborated and reiterated that Hindus and Muslims could very well co-exist in peace.

He made no discrimination in the Indians. Untouchability was in practice a lot at that time. Gandhi spread the message that all are the children of God and no discrimination should be done. He always stood in the support of the untouchables. He named them 'Harijans', means children or people of God (Hari).

In this way, he spread the message of humanity among all the people and people praised him a lot. He became a national hero and was given the title of 'Father of the Nation'.
